What You Need

Preschool-safe tea set OR preschool-safe cups and pitcher and a large

What You Do

"I'm thirsty! Let's have a tea party! Please, sit on my blanket so we can have some tea! (Do activity.)

October 2020, Week 3 Preschool and Kindergarten Activities

Today's Bible Story: God hears me and gives me what I need.

Hagar • *Genesis 21:14-20*

Memory Verse: "God is with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9, NLT

Key Question: Who's got it? **Bottom Line:** God's got it. **Basic Truth:** God loves me.

1. Obstacle Course

What You Need: Plastic cones, a tunnel, and floor tape (if you don't have cones or a tunnel use whatever you have in the house)

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Use the supplies provided to create a fun obstacle course in your activity area. You can place the plastic cones in a row for them to zig zag around. You can lay the tunnel on the floor for your child to crawl through. You can use the tape to create zig zag or curving lines for them to follow.

During the Activity Walk through the course once to explain each obstacle to your family. Then, one at a time, let your family walk through the course to get to the end!

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "I have something SUPER fun for us today. It's an obstacle course. Let me show you what to do!"

After the Activity: "You did a GREAT job. That was so fun! This is a great reminder that no matter where we go, God is WITH us! He hears us and helps us, because He loves us. No problem is too big for God! **Who's got it?** [Bottom Line] God's got it."

2. Hagar color sheet

What You Need: Color sheet, sand (dirt), blue tissue, marker, crayons, glue sticks, white glue, q-tip

What You Do: Give your child a color sheet. Put white glue on the part of the picture that looks like land and then have the children spread it out with the q-tip. Help them sprinkle sand (dirt) over the glue. Next have them use gluesticks to put blue tissue on the part of the picture that looks like water (if you don't have tissue paper have your child color the water blue). Then they can finish coloring the picture.

What You Say: "In our Bible story today we learned about when Hagar and her son were walking through the hot desert. Do you see the part of the picture that looks like the desert? Let's put some sand on that area. Hagar and her son were super thirsty but didn't have any water and started crying. God heard their cries and sent an angel from heaven and said, 'Do not be afraid. God will take care of your son.' When Hagar opened her eyes, she saw a well of water! Let's glue some blue tissue paper to the water. Now you can color the rest of the picture. God heard Hagar's prayer, and He hears ours, too. God will always give us what we need because He loves us. So tell me, who's got it? [Bottom Line] God's got it."
