Questions for the Week of April 17

1. Share about a memorable Easter from your past—whether funny, very meaningful, special, or unusual.

4. Of all the descriptions of Jesus in Revelation 1:12-20, what is the one that most stands out to you as important in today's world and in your personal life? Why? In what ways does this vision help us to "meet Jesus again" in a fresh way?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-22. Why is the physical, bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ so central to the Christian faith? An what is the practical impact of it?
6. Who is the One Life in your life who needs to meet Jesus in a profound way? Spend time in prayer for you to be the winsome witness to that One Life and for God to open his/her heart to his love.
